

**List of questions to the final module control on discipline "Care of patients in surgery (practice)" for the students of II course**

1. Ethics and deontology in the care of patients.
2. Aseptic. Methods of asepsis.
3. Antiseptics. Types of antiseptics.
4. Prepare the appropriate disinfectant solution and sanitize the bedside table and window sills in the ward.
5. Prepare the appropriate disinfectant solution and carry out a wet cleaning manipulation.
6. Prepare the appropriate disinfectant solution and carry out the processing of medical supplies for repeated use (thermometer, enema tips, bed-pan).
7. Conduct a survey of the patient and fill out the title page of the medical history.
8. Structure and functions of the admitting department.
9. Conduct a survey of the patient and identify the main complaints.
10. Carry out measurements of the body temperature of the patient and write down in a temperature sheet.
11. Conduct an examination of the patient for the presence of scabies and lice. Know how to sanitize.
12. Carry out measurements of the patient's height while standing, sitting, determine the body weight and calculate the body mass index.
13. Prepare a hygienic bath for sanitizing the patient and disinfect it after use. to carry out her disinfection after use.
14. Demonstrate the method of transporting the patient on a wheel-stretcher (wheel-chair) and shifting it onto the bed.
15. Demonstrate the skills of using the functional bed and providing appropriate positions to the patient with a fit of choking and collapse.
16. To investigate the patient's pulse on the radial arteries, to draw a conclusion about its basic properties.
17. To investigate the patient's pulse on the lower limbs, to conclude that it corresponds to the norm.
18. Measure the patient's blood pressure, make a conclusion about its compliance with the norm.
19. Conduct a study of patient's respiration, to draw a conclusion about its basic properties.
20. On the temperature sheet, write the parameters of the pulse, blood pressure, and body temperature. Make a conclusion about their compliance with the norm and the type of temperature curve.
21. Carry out replacement of bed linen and underwear for a patient who is on bed rest.
22. To lay out on the demonstration table the medicinal products offered by groups, the method of insertion and the main methods of insertio the medicines.
23. Demonstrate the technique instill of drops in ears, nose, eyes.
24. Demonstrate the methodology for preparing a rubber hot water bottle and a bubble with ice and using them.
25. Demonstrate the method of feeding a heavy patient.

26. Prepare the necessary equipment for a cleansing enema, demonstrate the methodology of its currig out.
27. Demonstrate gastric lavage with a tube.
28. Demonstrate cateterization of female and male urinary bladder.
29. Demonstrate the method of using a bedpan and urinal on male and female patients.
30. Prepare dishes for taking urine analysis according to Zimnitsky, give appropriate instructions to the patient.
31. Prepare necessary means and prevent the formation of bed sores.
32. Demonstrate the methodology of resuscitation (artificial lung ventilation, artificial heart massage) on the phantom.
33. Demonstrate the technique of utilization of dressings contaminated with purulent discharge in the purulent dressing.
34. Tell the modern methods of preparation the hands of the surgeon.
35. Demonstrate the technique of dressing operational sergical gown, mask, glowes.
36. Demonstrate the preparation the operative field (Grossich-Filonchicov's method).
37. Demonstrate the procedure for the production of napkins, tampons, balls for the care of a surgical patient and the rules for their utilization after use.
38. Demonstrate the rules for imposing a «Capeline bandage» and «Hippocratic cap».
39. Apply a bandage on both eyes and on the ears.
40. Demonstrate the technique of the bridle dressing and sling bandage on head.
41. Apply Application of bandages Deso, Velpeau.
42. Apply a typical bandage of the abdomen and bandage on the chest.
43. Apply a bandage to the shoulder joint.
44. Apply a bandage to the elbow joint.
45. Put the bandage on the knee and ankle joint.
46. Apply a bandage on the wrist and fingers.
47. Prepare surgical clothing and dressings material for sterilization.
48. Prepare surgical instruments for sterilization.
49. Carry out tests for the quality of pre-sterilization treatment of tools.
50. Demonstrate the methods of sterilization of suture material.
51. On the phantom to demonstrate the preparation for the operation of the patient's skin and sanation of the oral cavity, having selected the necessary means for this.
