

General Statements

Doctor's medical practice is carried out in accordance with the curriculum of the educational program 222 Medicine at 8 and 10 semesters, after the summer session. The student works as a doctor's assistant in inpatient and outpatient departments / offices of therapeutic, surgical, pediatric, obstetrics and gynecology profile of regional, city, district hospitals. The duration of medical practice is 4 weeks (4 ECTS credits) per semester. Students work at the base during 6 hours daily, 5 working days a week. In special cases, the procedure of conducting of medical practice is determined by separate orders and directives.

The purpose of Doctor's medical practice:

The purpose of the discipline is to achieve students' modern knowledge and consolidate professional skills acquired during studying the basic clinical and theoretical disciplines, and further improvement of practical skills in future activities at the district, city, regional medical institutions, in compliance with medical ethics and deontology.

Expected learning outcomes of the discipline:

- to determine the leading pathological symptoms and syndromes in the most common diseases;
- to make a differential diagnosis and make a preliminary diagnosis of the most common diseases;
- to prescribe the patient the best methods of instrumental examination using the standards of evidence-based medicine;
- to perform the necessary medical manipulations;
- to carry out reanimation measures and provide the first aid to victims;
- to demonstrate mastery of moral and deontological principles of a medical specialist and the principles of professional subordination.

Doctor's medical practice is conducted at the clinical bases of the departments of the SSU Medical Institute (MI): obstetrics, gynecology and family planning; internal medicine with a center of respiratory medicine; emergency medical care and disaster medicine; family medicine with a course in dermatovenereology; pediatrics; surgery, traumatology, orthopedics and tuberculosis.

Students can independently choose a base of practice outside the clinical bases of MI. Applications for practice outside the clinical bases of MI is submitted no later than two months before the start of the practice to the dean's office of MI. For foreign students, practice bases can be located in the countries - customers of specialists.

Before the practice, the student must undergo a medical examination, be vaccinated in accordance with the calendar and anti-epidemic recommendations.

Before the practice, the student receives instruction and a practice diary from the head of the practice from the university. In the hospital the student is instructed in safety. During the practice, the student complies with rules of the internal regulations of the medical institutions.
