## Regulations for surgery exam "Emergency abdominal surgery and proctology" for students of the 4th year of the speciality "Medicine"

The criterion for admission to the exam is the completion of the entire program in the subject, i.e. all topics without exception have been mastered at least with a minimum positive grade ("3")

The exam consists of two parts: theoretical and practical.

The ticket of the theoretical part contains three questions, two of them reveal the definition of nosological unit, etiology, pathogenesis, classification, clinic, diagnosis, differential diagnosis and treatment; the third question is a clinical task, under the terms of which the student makes a preliminary or clinical diagnosis, interprets symptoms, prescribes and interprets the results of laboratory or instrumental diagnostic methods, determines treatment tactics, prescribes conservative therapy or preoperative preparation, substantiates indications and contraindications, and also chooses the most likely the method of operation and determines the management of the postoperative period.

The ticket of the practical part contains seven tasks, six of which are objective clinical symptoms, which the student demonstrates as a manual skill on extras, justifying the manifestations and mechanism of the symptom. The seventh task is to interpret three x-rays of various pathologies according to the subject of the program.

The exam is evaluated for a total of 80 points, of which 40 are for the theoretical and practical parts. Grade "5" - 40 points, "4" - 32 points, "3" - 24 points.

The total number of points and the evaluation according to the ECTS system consists of points for current performance and points from the exam.
